RADIUS Feature Set End-of-Sale Notice

This notice is an announcement that the RADIUS feature set is being discontinued and that the feature will no longer be available for order or shipment effective June 30th, 2010. This is the Last-Order-Date (LOD) for all Infoblox customers, both existing users of RADIUS as well as new customers.

Infoblox will not sell or renew any RADIUS support/maintenance contracts where the support/maintenance contract termination date is past the End-Of-Life (EOL) date of 12/31/2012.

If a customer has purchased a RADIUS support/maintenance contract prior to 6/30/2010 which ends after 12/31/2012 Infoblox will continue to support that customer until the expiration of their support contract.

Hardware used for other services such as DNS or DHCP can be supported past 12/31/2012 but that support will not include RADIUS software support and must have a current support contract associated with the unit.

Note: The last NIOS release that includes the RADIUS feature set is 4.3r6. Infoblox will provide critical bug fixes to this release during the support period but will not be making any feature improvements or enhancements to this software.
